Paper merchant banks on large-format equipment

Paper merchant Carl Beberich, one of the big players in Germany and Austria, offers graphic fine papers, office papers, envelopes and bags, but also calendars, presentation boxes and slip cases. The company's equipment includes various units from Baumann-Wohlenberg, and the latest additions are a modern format 6 restacking station as well as a large-format cutting system with a Wohlenberg 225.

The restacking unit is used for the restacking of unwrapped materials, for order picking, to remove waste within the stack or to turn a poorly laid stack into a well laid stack. The system consists of a Baumann BB6-L-P loading unit and a Baumann BA6 Automat P unloading unit. It enables to process single and double stacks on twin pallets. The feeder can take double stacks and destack them in single stacks. In addition, it is possible to process small-format stacks, to combine them on the table of the unloader and to automatically destack them as double stacks on twin pallets.

The high-speed cutter comprises a pile lifter BSH6, a loading unit BB6 L-P, a WB 225 high-speed cutter as well as a BA6-Z-A unloading unit. Feeding of the high-speed cutter is carried out manually via the front table or alternatively automatically via the rear table. The high-speed cutter has a

cutting width of up to 5 cm and is equipped with a magnetic hovering saddle which offers higher speed compared to the previously used drives. The unloader is equipped with an innovative system that puts less strain on the layers so that the material can be destacked damage-free.

Stuttgart Media University receives Baumann-Wohlenberg system

A few weeks ago, Volkmar Assmann, Managing Director of Baumann Maschinenbau Solms, was happy to hand over a format 3 "manual cutting system" to the HDM Media University in Stuttgart which the students of the various courses of study can now use to gain practical experience in post-print processes. The system is composed of a BSH 3 pile lifter, a BSB 3 L automated jogging system, a Wohlenberg high-speed cutter with a cutting width of 115 cm as well as a Baumann BA 3 Ne unloader. At the ceremony, Assmann highlighted the great importance that his company attaches to the promotion of junior talents and promised that Baumann-Wohlenberg will continue to invest not only in research and development, but also in the basic and further training of staff.
